This is also a good place to mention where you plan to buy the food, any close ties you have to local restaurant vendors, such as food supply companies or products from local farms that will give you a competitive edge. If the answer is no, then you need to sell them on the idea that despite your lack of experience, you are still the perfect person for this new business. How much is this stellar business plan going to cost? There are three parts to a market analysis: Industry- Who are you going to be serving? They already have a loyal customer base, and luring customers from that base is not always easy. Find out as much as you can about your competition, including their menu, hours and prices. There is truly something for everyone! Perhaps you will offer a kids eat free coupon, or free lunch delivery to local offices. Families with young children? If not, do you have any experience in the restaurant business? In addition, the file contains a Teacher Pacing Guide which you can also see in the preview.
